

Build a Washtub Bass!

*A Post Hole Digger or Shovel
Handle is Rigid Enough.
A Broom Handle is too flimsy!*

*Use 1.06 inch
guage
WeedEater
Line, Actual
Bass Strings
don't work. Use
Hose clamp to
fasten string to
handle*

*Place foot
on this edge*

*Use Only a Number 3
Tub, Made in USA*

Tie String inside tub with washers and duct tape, through a Kitchen Sink Stopper.

These things really work!

It's function is to keep a band on the

Beat.. (Boom, Boom, Boom)

You can put one together for less than

\$40, a wooden Kay bass is \$900.

By leveraging the string, you can hit

the right notes (downbeat is a root,

upbeat is a fifth).

Cut a Golf Ball sized hole in top

(Woofers) place tub on a rubber carpet.

Don't paint tub, that ruins the tone.
